Welcome to the **Lloydminster Competitive Softball Association (LCSA)**! The **LCSA** is a non-profit organization which seeks to provide a framework for a positive and exciting experience for minor softball players in our community.

With players from all over the prairies, the **LCSA** facilitates the creation of competitive travel teams based out of Lloydminster. Additionally, the **LCSA** fields developmental 'B' teams to continue player development in a competitive and fun environment. The **LCSA** has also partnered with Softball Alberta to launch Lloydminster's first Learn to Play Program to introduce children ages 4-8 years old to the sport of softball. Additionally, in 2009 the **LCSA** created and introduced to Lloydminster, the **Hot Corner Softball League** for Mite and Squirt aged players. Through these and other activities, which have been embraced by other minor softball programs in recent years, the **LCSA** has been a leader in finding exciting and engaging methods to foster skill development at the grass roots level.

The **LCSA** has two primary revenue sources: (a) the annual Rebels Tournament held in June at Legion Ball Park and (b) Registration fees. In 2012, this will also be augmented by the **LCSA** raffle. This raffle will allow the **LCSA** to keep it's fees as low as possible while providing an opportunity for families to sell tickets to friends and family to recover the cost of participation. These revenues are directed towards procurement of team equipment, uniforms, facility fees and other required team expenses. The **LCSA** is governed by the Executive Committee duly elected/appointed at our annual AGM as outlined in the **LCSA's** by-laws. Additional costs incurred by individual teams are dealt with through individual team budgets which are set and administered by the designated team representative. Each team has the autonomy to determine what its goals and ambitions are for the ball season and the resulting increased fees which must be in place to meet costs.
